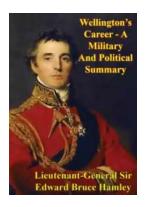

I've collected 101 tips and tricks about London that include such things as:

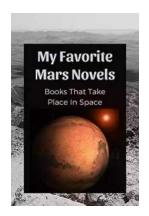
