

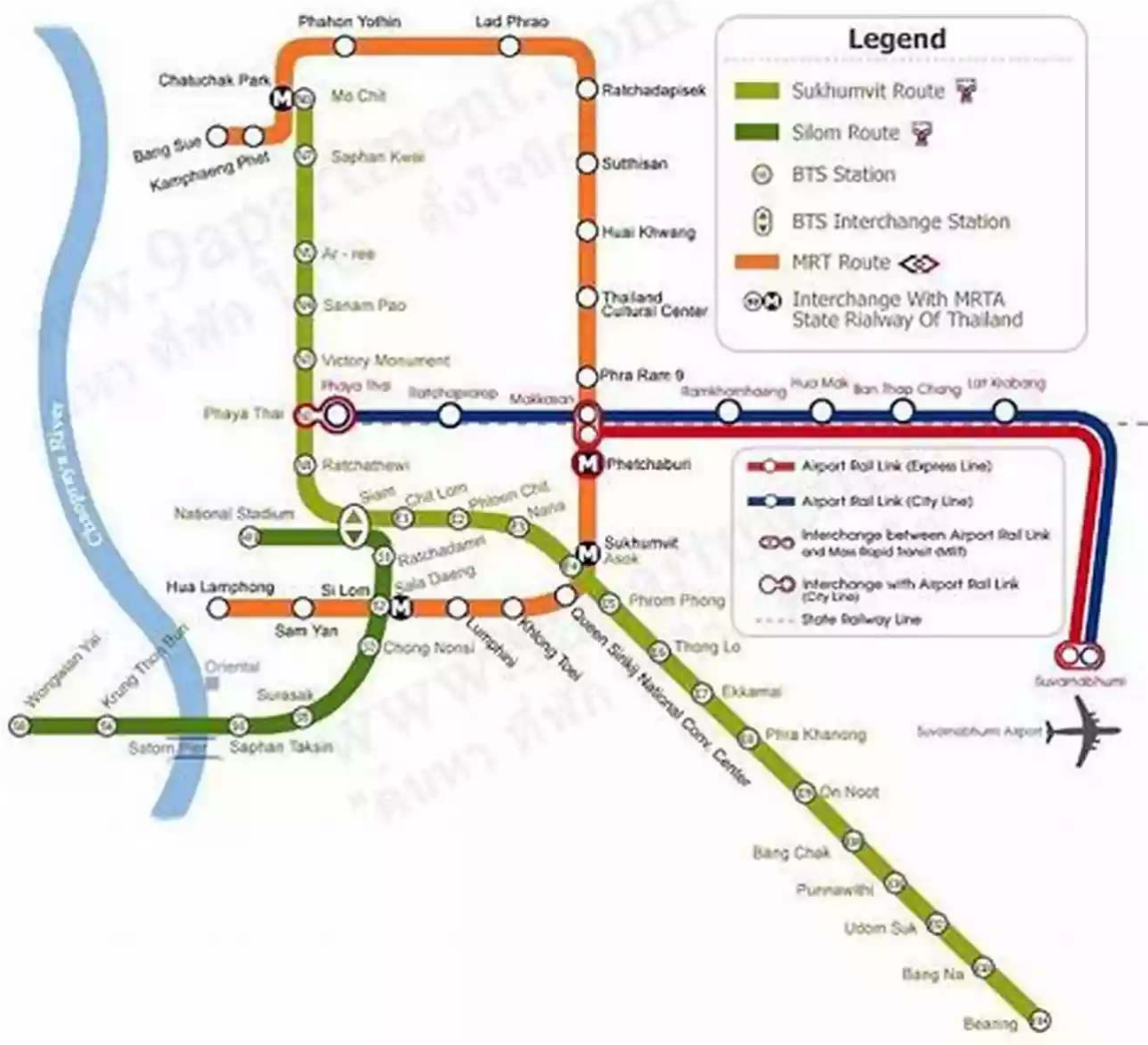

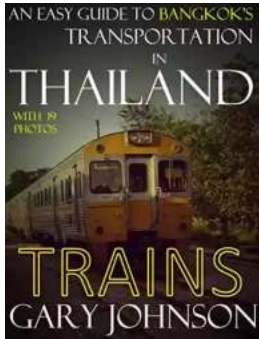
1. BTS Skytrain

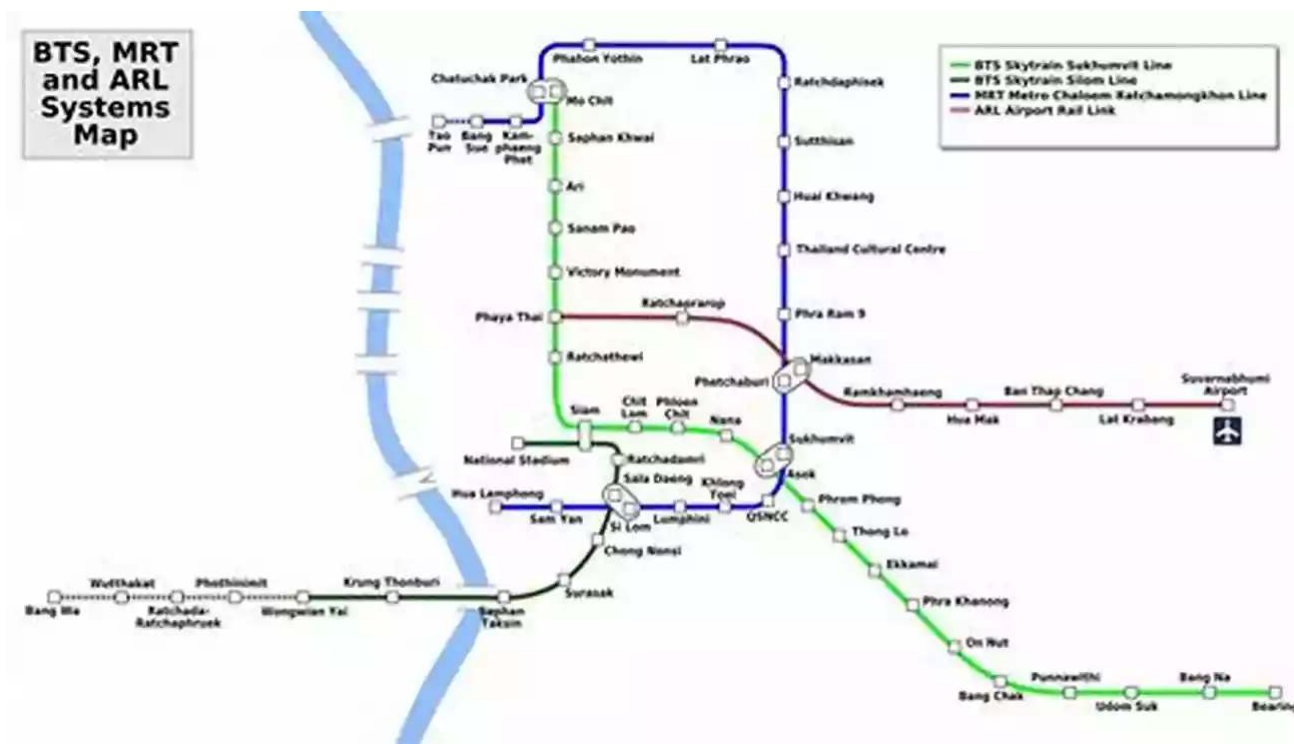
2. MRT Subway

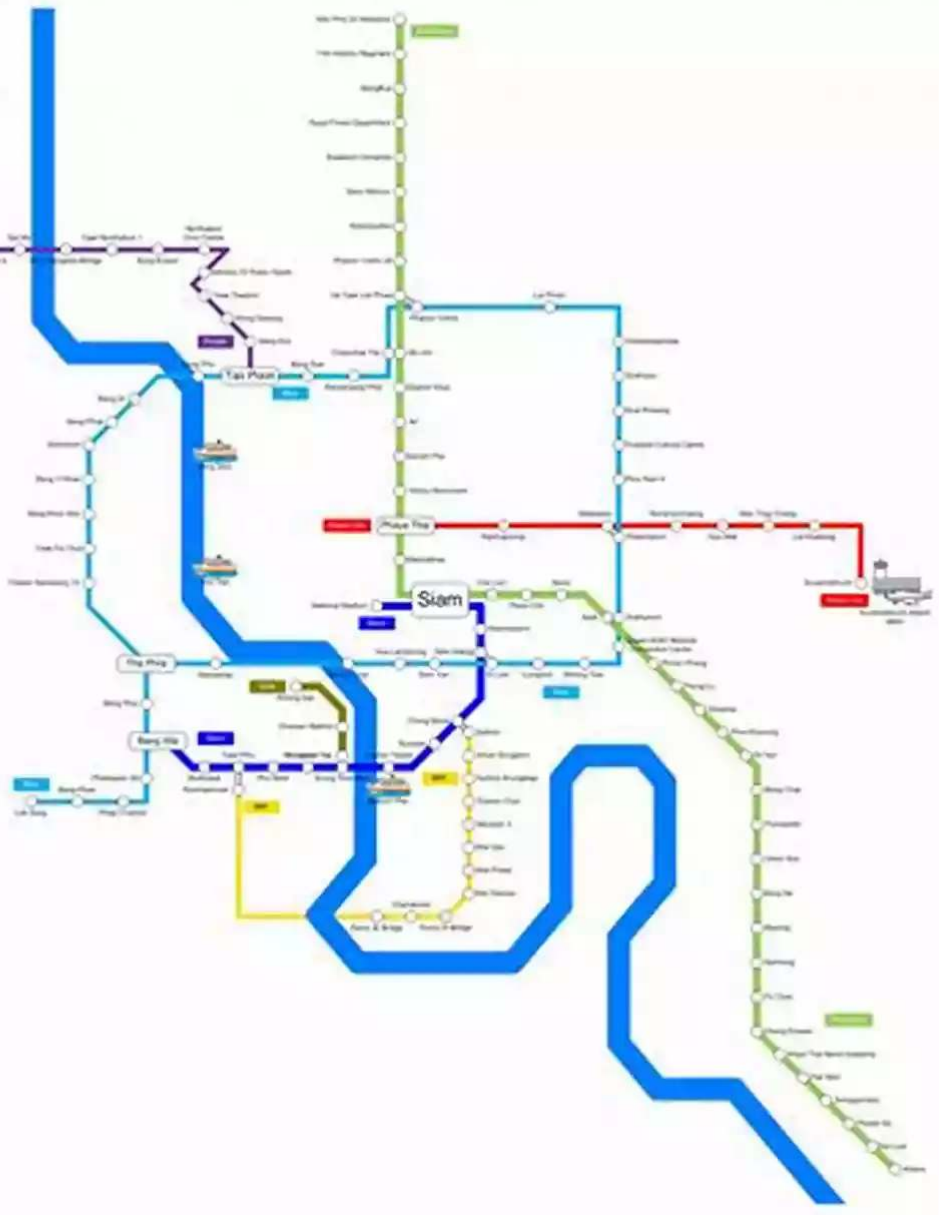


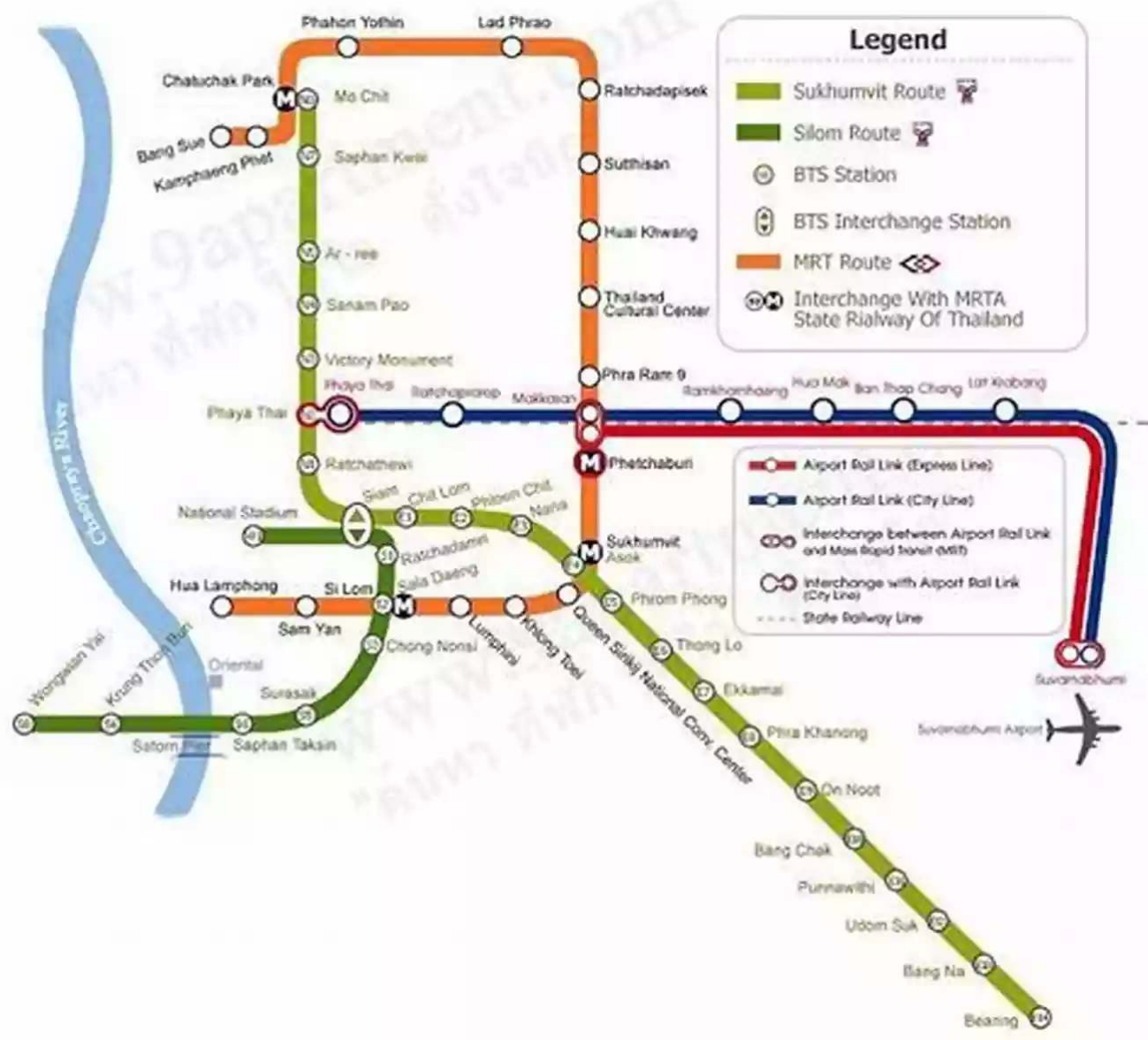




Ryukyu Kōriyū

The System Map of Bangkok Rail Transit Network



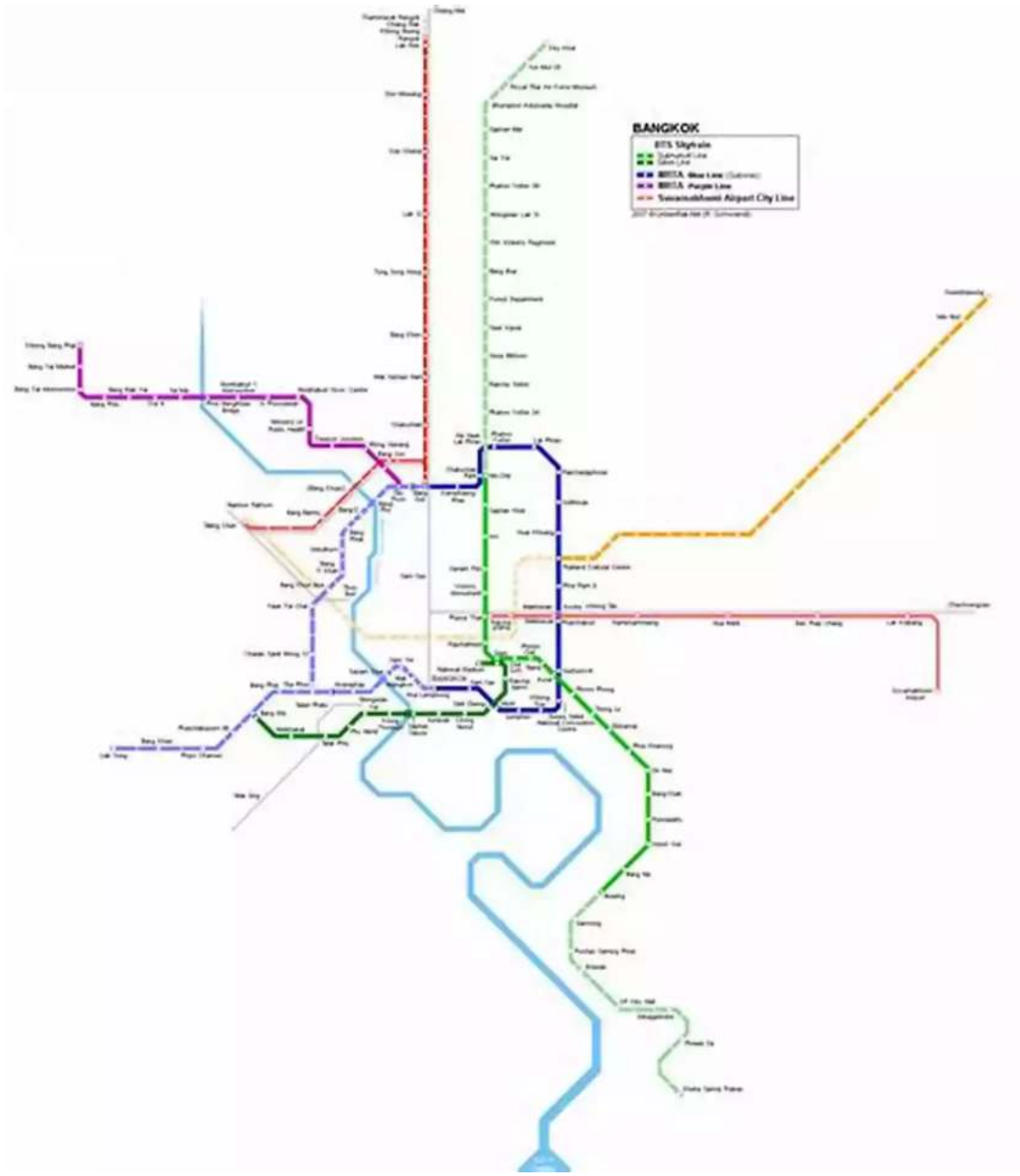
