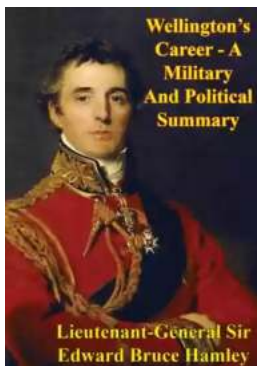
Why are these professions usually a matter of confusion? What is the role of a Project Manager? What is the purpose of a Business Analyst? What are each other responsibilities and do they overlap?

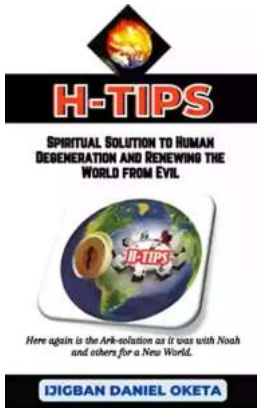
