


Introduction:

The common starfish is an excellent animal to dissect in order to demonstrate the basic features of a higher invertebrate phylum, Echinodermata. Starfish are unique among invertebrates that we have studied (earthworms, grasshoppers, clams, crayfish). This uniqueness is due to the fact that starfish and other Echinodermata (the phylum starfish belong to) are Deuterostomes as opposed to being Protostomes. Phyla that are Deuterostomes include: Chaetognatha, Echinodermata, Hemichordata and Chordata. The major differences between the Protostomes and Deuterostomes are outlined in the table below.

It is interesting to note that well over three-fourths of all animals are Protostomes. In the embryonic development of most invertebrates, the blastopore becomes the mouth which classifies them as Protostomia (first mouth). The phylum Echinodermata is the only major group of invertebrates that undergoes deuterostomic (second mouth)


Ling Chung is pleased to present her new picture book for kids. This easy reading book for children contains fun facts about starfish or also known as the sea star.



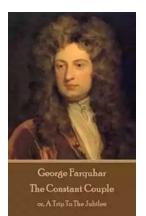
