Joseph Plumb Martin (November 21, 1760 – May 2, 1850),born in Massachusetts, was a soldier in the Continental Army during the American Revolutionary War. Martin participated in the Battle of Brooklyn, the Battle of White Plains, the siege on Fort Mifflin and the Battle of Monmouth. He witnessed John Andre being escorted to his execution and the climactic Siege of Yorktown. Martin was discharged in 1783. He subsequently taught in New York for a year before settling in Maine, becoming one of the founders of the town of Prospect. In

1836, a platoon of US Light Infantry marching though Prospect stopped outside of his house and fired a salute in honour of the Revolutionary War Hero. Joseph Martin died on May 2, 1850, at the age of 89
