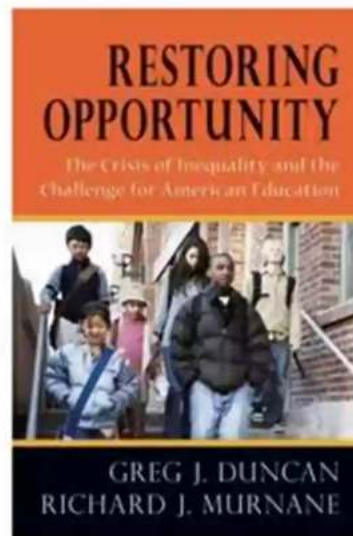


# The Crisis Of Inequality And The Challenge For American Education

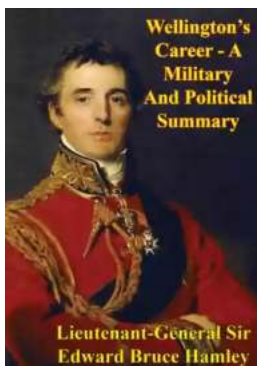
