

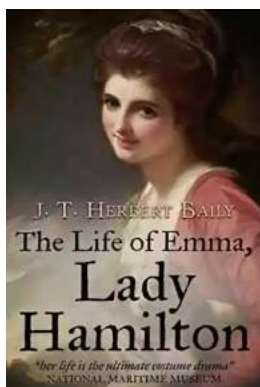

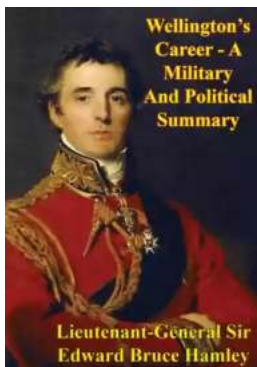

Though both were married, they secretly carried on an affair that produced a daughter and lasted until the day of Nelson's death, from which Emma never truly recovered.
