



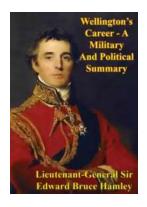

It was, however, the 98th Bruce Anti-tank Battery of the Royal Canadian Artillery (RCA), with its M-10 self-propelled AT guns (SPs or Wolverines), that became Port Elgin's primary military contribution to the Allied cause. As part of the 5th Canadian Armoured Division, the battles in which it participated include the crossing of the Melfa River (in the Liri Valley – near Monte Cassino and Anzio), the breaking of the Gothic Line, and the advance through the eastern Romagna. Subsequent operations in Northwest Europe completed the battery's journey. Anti-tank warfare has generally not received a great deal of attention in much of the existing historiography, but Port Elgin's War provides analysis on the development and application of Canadian antitank doctrine and tactics. Although the 98th Anti-tank Battery was a small unit, its impact on the course of several engagements during the Italian campaign was significant. Port Elgin's War illustrates why this was so.
