
William K. Harvey was the CIA's most daring and successful field operator during the tense, early days of the Cold War. Harvey's continuing friendship with Johnny Rosselli, a Mafia figure who had helped the CIA with Cuban operations, opened further questions as some—most notably Robert Blakey, former chief counsel to

the House Subcommittee on Assassinations—linked Rosselli to JFK's assassination.
