He was awarded five clasps with his General Service Medal, and also received the Waterloo medal. In 1822 he was discharged in Port Royal, Jamaica where many had died of yellow fever during the preceding 3 years. Donald returned to Teangue, Isle of Skye as a Chelsea out-pensioner, receiving an army pension of one shilling per day, and continued his life as a crofter. He experienced the extreme trauma of campaigning, witnessed the horrors of war, survived wounds and diseases, and became one of 'The Brave Sons of Skye'.

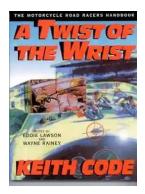

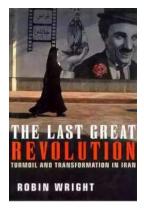
